

FAIR HOUSING IS THE LAW

Under Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, it is illegal to discriminate against any person because of race, color, religion, sex, or national origin:

- *In the sale of rental of housing or residential lots*
- *In advertising the sale or rental of housing*
- *In the financing of housing*
- *In the provision of real estate brokerage services*

“Blockbusting” is also illegal.

IF YOU ARE DISCRIMINATED AGAINST:

You may call on the federal government for help. Complaints must be filed with the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) within 180 days of the incident. You can:

It is illegal to Discriminate Against Any Person Because of Race, Color, Religion, Sex, Handicap, Familial Status, or National Origin

- In the sale or rental of housing or residential lots
- In advertising the sale or rental of housing
- In the financing of housing
- In the provision of real estate brokerage services
- In the appraisal of housing
- Blockbusting is also illegal

- En la financiación de la vivienda
- En la provisión de servicios de corredores de bienes raíces
- En la tasación de viviendas
- Las tácticas de intimidación (Blockbusting) también son ilegales
