






Traffic studies have found hundreds of cars at dangerous speeds in Lee County School zones

PROBLEM

Traffic studies found hundreds of drivers each day exceeding more than 10+ mph over the speed limit in school zones.

SOLUTION



School zone cameras have proven to reduce speeds and improve safety.

OUTCOME



Reducing a motorist's speed by only 5 mph doubles the child's chance of survival if struck by a vehicle.

- School Zone Cameras work throughout Georgia.
- Significant reductions in speed.
- Low rate of recidivism.

Enforcement Hours

Citations will only be issued from one hour before school, throughout the school day, to one hour after, only when school is in session.



The goal of the program is to get driver's to slow down.



Motorists will only be cited if they exceed the school zone limit by 11



All funds collected are used for Public Safety programs.



First citation is \$75. Subsequent citations are \$125. Civil infraction - no points or insurance increase.
